- What color was the Schwa's house? (Canary yellow)
- What did the Schwa like to collect? (Famous paper clips)
- Name 3 famous paper clips in the Schwa's collection. (Nuclear Arms Treaty signed by Reagan and Gorbachev; original lyrics of "Hey Jude;" mission manual for the space shuttle)
