

SJA Throwback — First Wedding in the New Church



The very first couple to be married in the newly organized parish was Bernard J. Cassel and Marion Hinterlong on September 2, 1925. But the first wedding in the new church building was the wedding mass of Joseph F. Miller and Bertha Long on June 25, 1927.

Rev. Peter Mizera, OSB, a priest at St. Procopius Abbey, who compiled a brief history of St. Joan of Arc, observed that Bertha and her sister Rose "devoted personal care, for two- and one-half years, to the upkeep of the chapel over the hardware store. This privilege of being the first to have her marriage solemnized in the new church, somewhat recompensed her for the services she

rendered to the parish during its humble beginnings." Her daughter, Dorothy Garhan, recalls helping her mother after evening prayers to prepare the altar for the next day. "I remember going up Saturday and there would be flowers there from someone's garden. She also did the church laundry. All that starch and pleats to iron in." Yes, Bertha, you earned the honor—not only was this the first wedding, it was also the first Mass in the new church.

At this time, wedding photography was not allowed inside the sanctuary, perhaps to honor the sacredness of the space or maybe because photographic equipment was so large and cumbersome.

Today both Bertha's great nephew, Jeff Koon and his wife Lisa Carpino Koon, are members of St. Joan of Arc and were also married at St. Joan's (but in the new church). Together they continue the legacy of Bertha's faithful service to our parish.




