**LENTEN DISCIPLINES OF
FASTING & ABSTINENCE**

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

'Glory to God'

As we enter into the Easter Triduum with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, we celebrate with traditions. We recognize the importance of these days as central to our Catholic faith. We recall the sacrifice of Christ for all of us as we celebrate the Paschal Mystery – His suffering, dying, and rising.

During the liturgies for both Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil, we sing the Gloria, the Church's ancient hymn of praise. Tradition calls for ringing of bells during this hymn on these days. **On both these evenings**, you are asked to bring bells (any type) to our liturgy. We will ring these bells during the singing of the Gloria.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

On Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we enter into the most sacred week of the year. At the 9:30am Mass on Sunday, March 24, we will gather in the PAR and have a solemn procession into the church (going outside – weather permitting) to begin our liturgy. Our Parish Choir, along with additional instrumentalists, will lead the music at the 9:30am Mass. Plan to arrive early for this liturgy, to get into the proper location for participating in the procession.

Seasonal Choir

We are looking for individuals interested in singing in our Seasonal Choir. Our Seasonal Choir joins members of our Parish Choir to sing for the Liturgies on Holy Thursday (7:00pm), Good Friday (3:00pm), and Easter Sunday (9:30am).

This is a wonderful opportunity for those who like to sing, but cannot make a regular commitment to singing every week.

The rehearsals will be on Tuesday evenings, March 5/12/19/26, following this schedule:

7:30pm to 8:15pm, Rehearsal for Holy Thursday

8:45pm to 9:15pm, Rehearsal for Easter Sunday

All rehearsals will take place in the church.

SJA Throwback — The Schumachers and the Sauls

Continuing our look at early families of St. Joan of Arc parish, Hubert and Mary Schumacher, like the Riedys and the Rotts, were charter members who had petitioned the Archdiocese of Chicago for a church in Lisle. Their names are included in a list of pew subscribers in the 1929 church dedication program. Pew subscriptions (rent) were not unique to Catholics-- this practice was a way to raise extra funds for the church—but eventually fell out of favor. At the time of the Schumacher's fiftieth anniversary on May 10, 1966, the local paper noted that the couple had 38 grandchildren (ages 1-18) and prayed the rosary daily since 1919. Hubert was also known to enjoy singing in the choir.

Another church family whose membership has spanned multiple generations are the Sauls. The early Saul family came to Lisle following their son, who entered St. Procopius Academy (later Benet Academy) in 1939 and from there, joined St. Procopius Abbey to become a monk and priest. Fr. James Saul remained at the abbey, supporting the Benedictine Chinese Mission as well as participating in the life of Benet Academy. His brother, Leonard, also attended St. Procopius Academy and graduated in 1948. Leonard's family moved to Lisle in 1952 and that same year, Len met Loretta Schumacher at a September novena at St. Joan of Arc. By June 1953, the two were wed and together raised a family of eight children. Born in Lisle, Loretta attended St. Joan of Arc school and fondly remembers Fr. Beller (1950-1967). If you attend the 7:30 am

Sunday Mass, you will surely see Loretta, with her two twin daughters, Jane and Jean, all who have served St. Joan of Arc in so many ways over the decades.

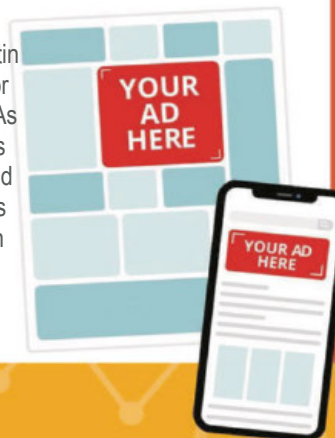

Parish Membership: Registration forms can be obtained on the parish website, at the Resource Center desk in the Narthex, or by contacting the Parish Office.

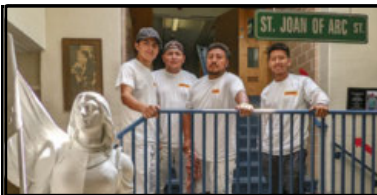
