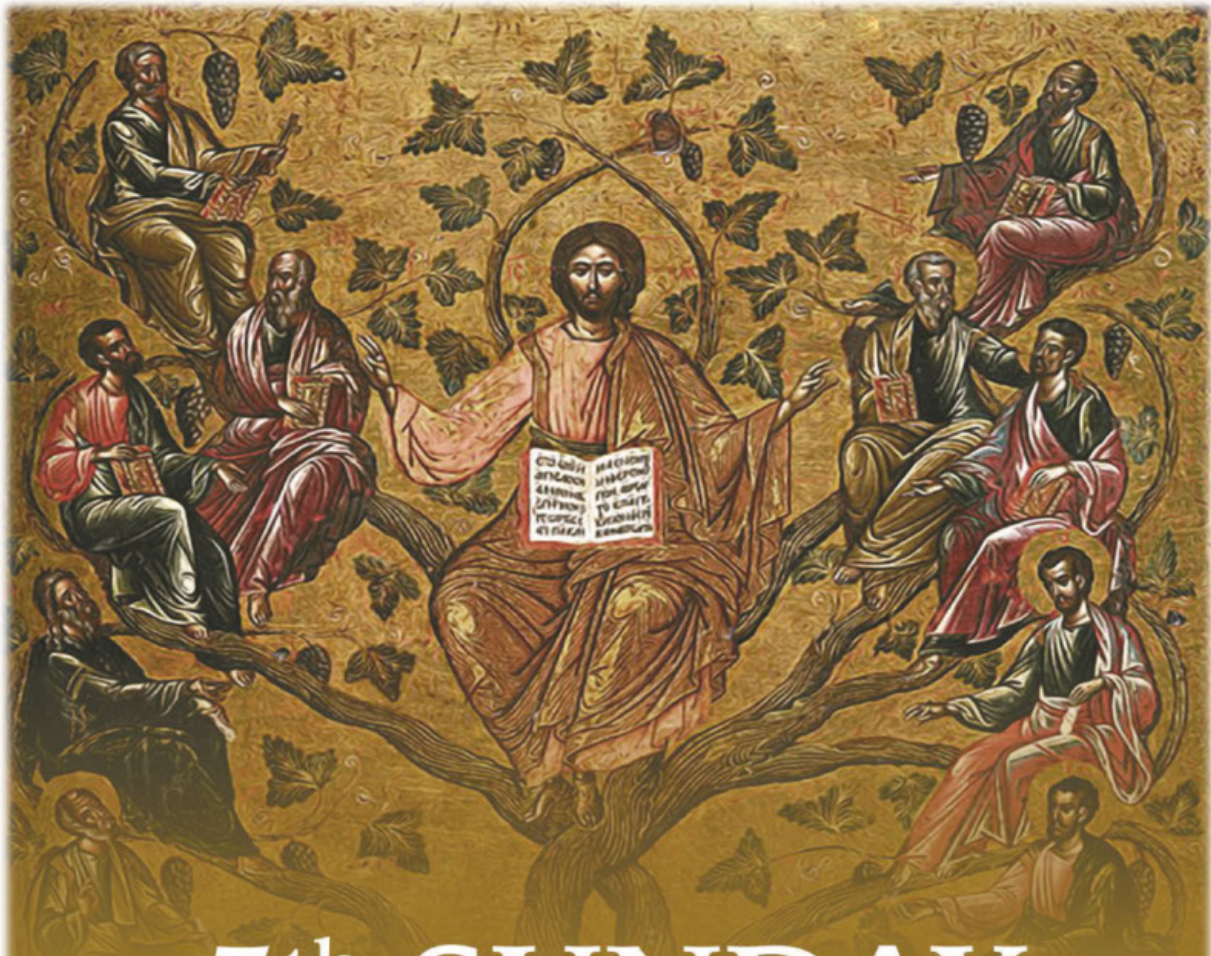

SJA Throwback — The Mary Altar



The Mary Altar or the Altar of Our Lady is a side altar in a Catholic church, usually the most prominent altar after the main or principal altar. While it is not part of the Marriage Rite, brides have traditionally presented flowers to Mary after the closing prayer, as a sign of love and devotion.

Brides pray to the Blessed Virgin Mary for guidance and strength as she is the model of the perfect spouse and mother. The beautiful custom of the bride leaving her bouquet on Mary's altar goes back to the seventeenth century, practiced throughout Europe and Latin America.

More recently both the bride and groom pray together at the Mary Altar and at the St. Joseph statue, as well. St. Joan of Arc's new church did not include a special altar to Mary, as the post-Vatican II emphasis was on the main altar. However, Fr. Gabriel recently installed the Shrine to the Mother of God and the Saints, allowing brides to continue the tradition. This impressive grouping, created by the artist Wiktor Szostalo, depicts the Virgin Mary

holding her son, the Christ Child whose arm is extended in a gesture of welcome. Surrounding the sculpture are fifteen lighted glass panels of saints illuminating not only the shrine but inspiring us all.

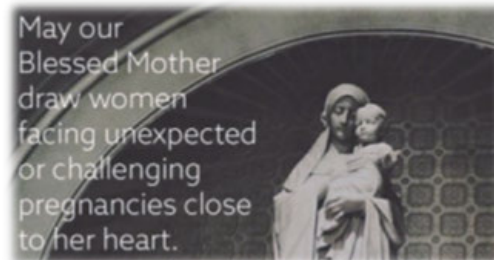

APRIL NURSE NOTES



Let's talk tea. We are finally leaving the chill of the winter season behind us, when we likely enjoyed a warm, soothing, beverages. Possibly that beverage was a favorite tea. 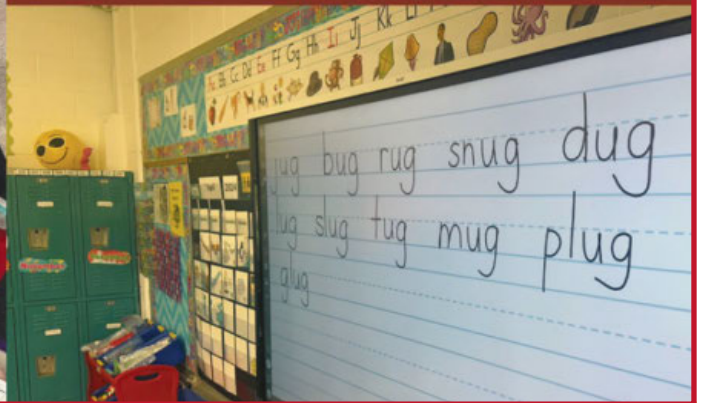

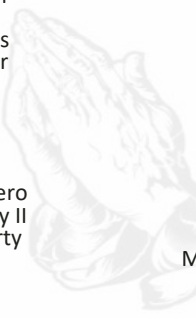
