

Honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary during the month of May has a long history in the Catholic Church. In addition to crowning Mary as Queen of Heaven, there are three Marian Feast Days in the month of May: Our Lady of Fatima (May 13); Mary Help of Christians (May 24) and the Visitation (May 31).

St. Joan of Arc continues the popular May Crowning tradition with the eighth graders presenting the living rosary and crowning Mary. In honor of their First Communion the second graders lead the procession at the beginning of the service.





St. Joan of Arc's Garden Ministry!





Baptisms: Parents are asked to call the Parish Office to make arrangements for Baptism. Please be advised that each godparent is required to submit a sponsor eligibility form prior to the parents receiving a date for their child's baptism. Parents of children to be baptized are required to attend a Baptism Prep class.

Marriages: Contact the Parish Office before making any other commitments. The diocese requires a minimum preparation time of six months between the first conference with the Pastor and the wedding.


