Honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary during the month of May has a long history in the Catholic Church. In addition to crowning Mary as Queen of Heaven, there are three Marian Feast Days in the month of May: Our Lady of Fatima (May 13); Mary Help of Christians (May 24) and the Visitation (May 31).

St. Joan of Arc continues the popular May Crowning tradition with the eighth graders presenting the living rosary and crowning Mary. In honor of their First Communion the second graders lead the procession at the beginning of the service.

Is it a coincidence that we honor Mary in the same month we celebrate Mother's Day? Though not generally acknowledged, the establishment of Mother's Day was most likely the Protestant response to this Catholic devotion. After all, Mary, Mother of God, is mother to us all.

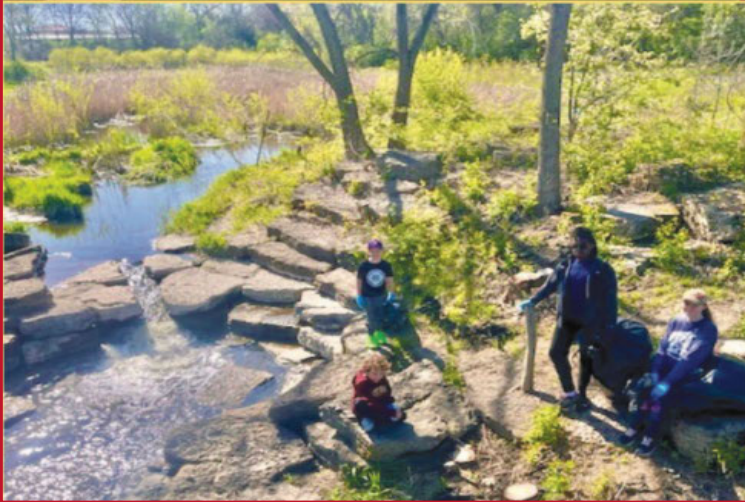

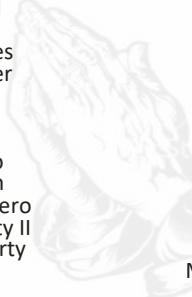

Parish Membership: Registration forms can be obtained on the parish website, at the Resource Center desk in the Narthex, or by contacting the Parish Office.

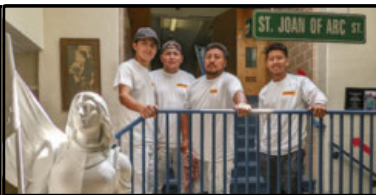
