The Bishop has outlined a roadmap that consists of 5 elements – Conversion, Confession, Communion, Commission, and Prayer. Each of these elements grows out of the one that preceded it among the Cs, and the P holds them together like the hub of a wheel. Fr. Gabriel took us through a PowerPoint presentation that spoke to each of the elements. Fr. Gabriel asked that the PPC help identify next steps as well as provide input on choosing a consultation group or framework to help renew the spirit of our parish.
