Saint Report

Your name gives you an identity. It tells others who you are. When you were baptized, your parent chose your name. If you do not know your parents' reason for choosing your name, ask them about it. Now that you are about to be confirmed, it is time to choose the name you will take as a sign of your growth in faith.

Your Confirmation name should reflect your new role as a mature Christian. The tradition of taking a name to show a new role can be traced to the Hebrew Scriptures. It is preferable to affirm your Baptism by choosing your Baptismal name. You may choose another name. If another is chosen it is to be the name of a canonized Saint who allowed God to be reflected in their life.

When you have decided on a name, you must research and write a report on the Saint's name and Saint you chose. Then type up the Saint report. The report should be at least three paragraphs.

- The first paragraph should include information about the Saint you chose i.e. date of birth, place of birth and particulars about the family the Saint grew up in. Make sure you include the Saint's Feast Day.
- The second paragraph should include the Saint's qualities or virtues and how you will imitate and live out those qualities throughout your life.
- The third paragraph should tell how by imitating this Saint, you can become a better Christian.

Each paragraph should have no less than five sentences.

The Saint report must be typed or computer printed with a cover page that includes:

- The Saint's name in the title.
- A picture of the Saint if possible.
- Your own name in the lower right corner.
